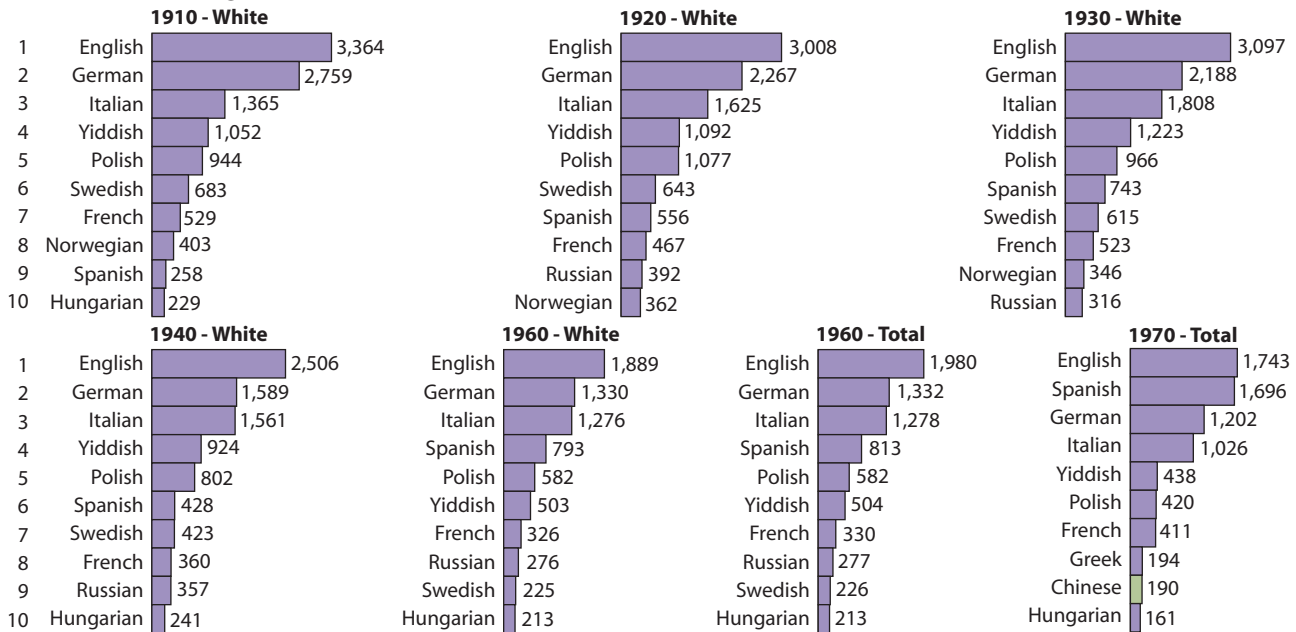

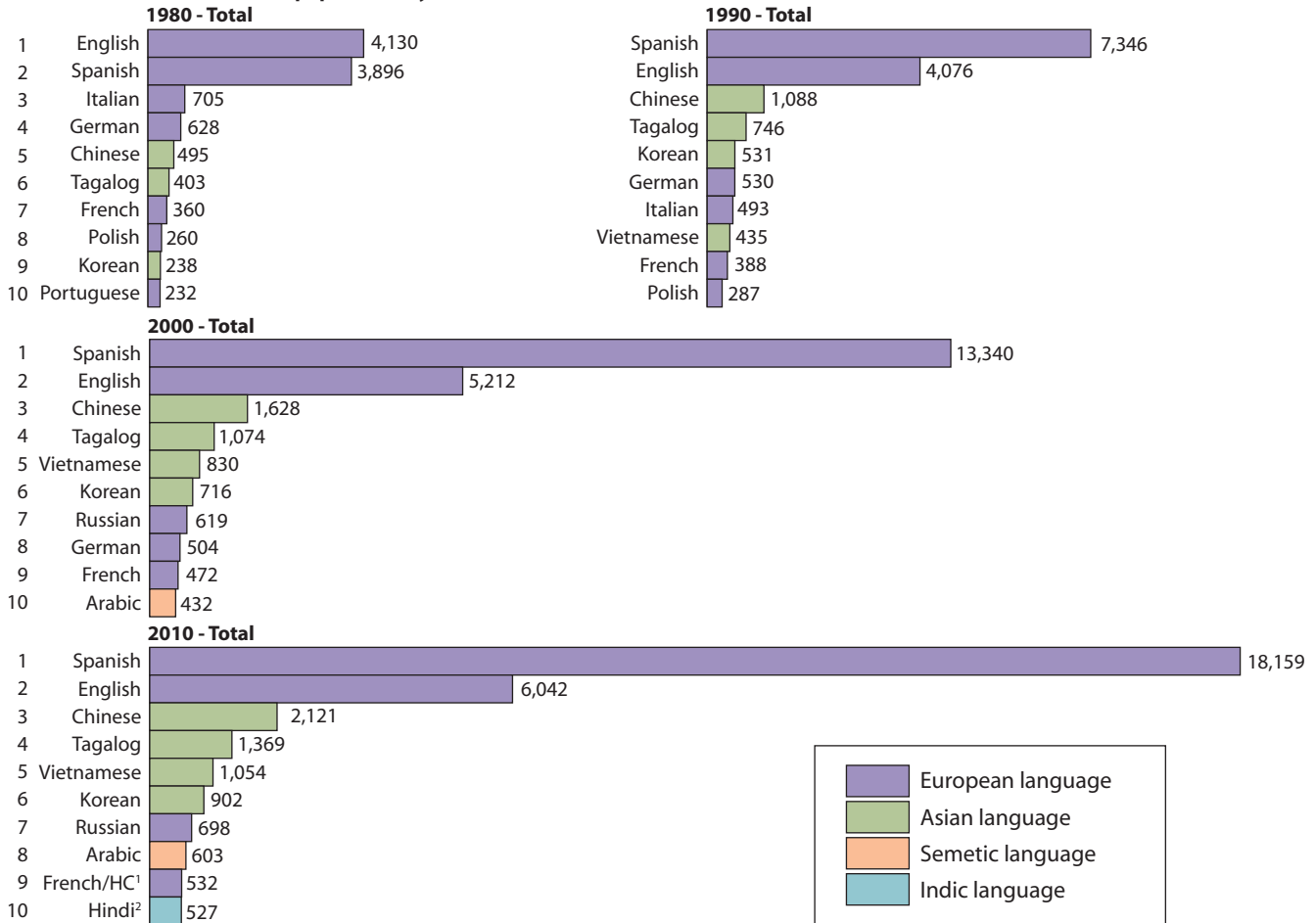
Ten Leading Languages for the Foreign-Born Population of the United States: 1910 to 2010
